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PUBLIC HEARING 1 CHAIRMAN OYAMA: It's 10 after 10:00. 2 We're starting with the public hearing. And I'm going 3 to pass along to our chief engineer, David Craddick, to 4 5 run through as a presenter to present the hearing. Is that all right? Okay? 6 7 MR. NISHIMURA: Yes sir. MS. SUZUKI: Is that what you agreed to? 8 9 We have a script right here. CHAIRMAN OYAMA:: 10 Yes. Start at the beginning. MS. SUZUKI: 11 So you just read --12 13 CHAIRMAN OYAMA: You just want me to read it? 14 MS. SUZUKI: Just read that first 15 paragraph, and I'll read the rest. 16 17 CHAIRMAN OYAMA: Okay. I'll read the 18 first. Okay. All right, here we go. Thank you. Okay. A public hearing will be today, Wednesday, 19 November 23rd, 2011, regarding the corrections to the 20 proposed amendments to the Rules and Regulations of Part 21 22 IV, affecting Sections I, V, and new Section XI, which 23 will be more specifically stated when the public hearing notice is read shortly. 24 Copies of the proposed rule amendment are 25

SUZUKI: The board will follow the 3 following procedures as laid out in Part I, Section VI, 4 5 Subsection III of the Department of Water, County of Kauai, Rules and Regulations in holding this public 6 7 hearing. A presentation will first be made by the 8 9 department regarding the proposed rules that are the subject of today's hearing. The department will then 10 ask if there are any questions the board may have 11 regarding the department's presentation. 12 The board will then take public testimony. 13 Which there's a signature that's out there. 14 15 MS. SHIRAMIZU: Nobody. MS. SUZUKI: If anyone wants to testify, 16 17 fill out the signature list. I see that no one is in the room. 18 If anyone is going to testify, state your name, 19 address, organization you're representing, and if you're 20 a registered lobbyist. 21 22 Limit your comments to the subject matter of today's public hearing. 23 Refrain from direct questioning of the board 24 and direct any remarks or questions to the chair. 25

Anyone speaking may be subsequently subject to 1 questioning. And questions by the board shall be 2 permitted only at the discretion of the chair. 3 The three-minute rule will be followed 4 5 regarding all testimony. So testimony should be limited to three minutes. If you don't complete your testimony, 6 7 you will be given another opportunity to speak what you want to say. 8 9 And the board shall not be bound by any technical rules of evidence. 10 Thank you. 14	views, arguments, or other testimony may be submitted
15	any time up to and including the date of the public
