10 A.M., August 26, DOW Update: Water conservation request lifted for Haena-Wainiha residents

HAENA – The Department of Water (DOW) has lifted the water conservation request for all Haena-Wainiha residents as of 10 a.m., today. All customers may now resume normal water use and consumption. Additionally, DOW personnel will be conducting water facilities assessments today, for the Wainiha-Haena water system. An update on water services affecting customers located on a portion of Kuhio Highway in Haena; between the Manoa Stream and Ke'e Beach will be provided as soon as the required assessments and repairs have been completed.
