Water services restored to customers on Ka'apuni Road in Kapa'a Partial one-lane road closure remains in place

KAPA'A – The Department of Water (DOW) has restored water service to all affected customers located on a portion of Ka'apuni Road in Kapa'a; between Kawaihau Road and approximately a half-mile south of Kepano Street on Ka'apuni Road and includes customers located on Alapaki Road, as of approximately 1:45 p.m. The contractor has completed the necessary work for the new service connection on Ka'apuni Road and customers may now resume normal water use.

The partial one-lane road closure on Ka'apuni Road, between Kawaihau Road to Olohena Road will remain in place for approximately 2 hours as the contractor finalizes repairs.

When the water main is turned back on, air and or existing sediment may be mixed into the water causing it to appear white or milky at the tap. This is normal, and if it occurs, customers may flush water out from an outside hose bib until the water is clear.

DOW thanks customers for their patience and cooperation during the scheduled and emergency service shutdown.
